State Science Olympiad Competition

After placing team 1st in the high school division and team 2nd in the middle school division at the Regional Science Olympiad in March, the WCS teams advanced to the State competition held at Texas A&M this past weekend. The student scientists competed in 23 different events against teams from public and private schools all over Texas. Events included building a car from a mouse trap that could travel forward and reverse automatically, designing and building a windmill that generates electricity, and using standard forensic tests to solve a crime.

Silver medals for the meet were won by Courtney Wilkins, Jada Autman, Micah Green, Joshua Reece, Justin Morgan, and Stephen Scott in various events.
