


Pizza Project

ABOUT THE PROJECT

After reading Gordon Korman's [*The Unteachables*](#), demonstrate your knowledge of the book with a creative and tasty-looking literary pizza!

DUE DATE

This is due the first week of school.

SUPPLIES

Use a 12"-15" in diameter circle made from white poster board or foam board for the pizza base. Use markers, crayons, colored pencils, construction paper, and/or other creative materials to make your toppings.

PLEASE DON'T USE A PIZZA BOX

Notice the example with the decorated pizza slices stapled on top of the information as a layer. This is a great strategy, but not the only way to both decorate and include your slices. You are welcome to be creative in how you present and design your pizza!

6 SLICES OF INFORMATION!

Slice 1: Characters: Make a list of the most important characters in the book with a brief description of each.

Slice 2: Setting: Describe in detail where most of the story takes place

Slice 3: Theme: What is the author trying to tell us? What is the underlying message? Some examples of themes are:

- Things are not always as they appear to be
- Your past doesn't define who you are.
- Believe in yourself.
- People are afraid of change

Slice 4: Problem and Solution: Describe a problem in the novel and how the problem is solved.

Slice 5: Summary: Describe what the story was mostly about

Slice 6: Title/Author: Write the title and author of the story.
