Westbury Christian School is a Christ-centered educational program that offers students from age 3 to 12th grade a college-preparatory experience in a diverse environment featuring challenging academics, vibrant spiritual life and comprehensive student activities to prepare them for here and eternity.

Westbury Christian School began with a vision from local Westbury families in 1970. The families saw a need to open a private Christian school in Southwest Houston that provides affordable Kingdom Education to all families regardless of Christian denomination or cultural background.

The birth of that vision occurred September 2nd, 1975, when WCS opened its doors to 45 students in preschool, kindergarten and 1st through 3rd grade. Beginning in 1978, a grade was added each year until the Upper School was completed with the first senior class graduating in 1984.

From its humble beginnings, Westbury Christian School has matured into a respected private, college-preparatory, interdenominational Christian school in Harris county. Today, our school now serves 300 students Pre-K3 through 12th grade representing over 70 Houston area churches.

Although much has changed since the school's inception 47 years ago, Westbury Christian has not wavered from its original mission of preparing youth for here and eternity. Westbury Christian strives to provide students excellent opportunities in academics, spirituality and student activities while instilling the values of servant leadership, compassionate leaders and lifelong learners.

Our EDUCATION PHILOSOPHY

1

We believe that the underlying source, goal, and direction of everything is the One revealed in the Bible as God, the Creator, Governor, and Redeemer of the universe.

We believe that while God is not unknown to His creatures through His creation, He has fully disclosed Himself and His intentions through the revelation of His Son, Jesus Christ. Sin, however, has distorted man's view of God, of creation, of himself, and of his fellow man.

We believe that God gives parents the responsibility for raising their children; thus, as those who are charged by parents to participate in the education of their children, we are partners in the education of the students at WCS. This partnership between the home and school is based on a common understanding and acceptance of the mission and values of the school.

We believe God created us as complex beings in His image; thus, true education seeks to develop the full individual in mind, soul, and spirit. Thus, as a Christian school, we believe students must be challenged and equipped to grow intellectually and academically, socially and emotionally, and spiritually and personally.

5

We believe that all reality is dependent upon God and is intended to reflect His goodness and glory. It is our understanding that all truth, properly understood, is God's truth and should be pursued, mastered, and celebrated as such.

We believe that true education is a process whereby we are led to better understand the world and to comprehend it as God's world. We believe that, since God creates us as persons in community, true education involves learning better to live together with all persons as the family of God.

We believe that, as partners in education, the school must integrate Biblical faith with all disciplines in a manner such that students may come to view themselves and their world through the eyes of faith. Teachers must exemplify this faith personally because Christian education has as much to do with character and conduct as it does with facts. It includes the development of dispositions, attitudes, and conduct that reflects trust in the Creator, Governor, and Redeemer of the universe.

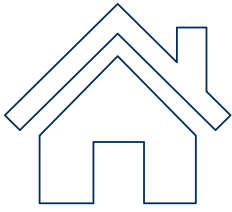

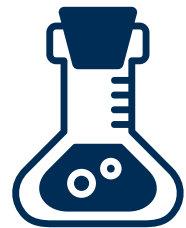

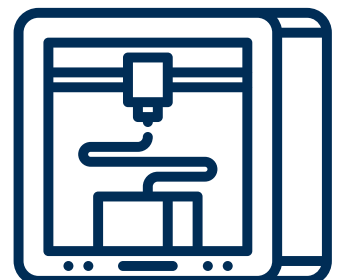
